MOOC as an instrument of education

A Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) is a free web-based distance learning program that is designed for large numbers of geographically dispersed trainees. Typically, these courses consist of traditional class materials made accessible online, which may include filmed or recorded video lectures, readings, online quizzes, and interactive learning modules. Typically, each MOOC will include a course provider and a course platform. A course provider is often a university, which supplies the course materials and instructors. The platform provides the technological infrastructure for course modules, user access and other learning resources.

MOOCs are important educational tools, increasingly used in the context of higher education, but they are also essential as instrument of informal and lifelong learning.

In this webinar we will explore its application in different contexts and understand how to design a MOOC.
